

## OCTOBER BOARD MEETING MINUTES

October 7, 2020 at 11 AM

The October board meeting was called to order by Town Chairman Scott Maciosek at 11:00 AM. All board members were present and one resident.

Pledge of the Allegiance was recited and posting of meeting verified.

Motion by Millie Ritzer to approve agenda in any order at discretion of Chairman Maciosek. Seconded by Francine Gough. Motion carried.

Motion made by Scott Maciosek to approve September meeting minutes. Seconded by Millie Ritzer. Motion carried.

Motion made by Millie Ritzer to approve bills for payment. Seconded by Mike Gough. Motion carried.

Motion made by Mike Gough to submit letter of support regarding Muskellunge Lake Association's grant application. Seconded by Millie Ritzer. Motion Carried.

Joe Eisle will be moving and is seeking for a replacement member for the Olson Memorial Library. Francine Gough has volunteered to take the vacancy and attend the meetings.

Motion made by Mike Gough to purchase a scanner/printer for Chairman and label maker & lap top computer for clerk with a contingency on lap top computer where it will be compatible with County's tax program and Cloverland's main computer. Seconded by Joe Spitz. Motion carried.

The storm damages Cloverland sustained on August 9, 2020 has been deemed by Green Bay National Weather Service as a tornado. Vilas County Emergency Government started the paperwork on Cloverland's behalf back in August requesting aid for the storm damage clean up. Motion made by Millie Ritzer to write up an "Emergency Declaration" and complete the "Local Applicant Request for State Public Assistance". Seconded by Francine Gough. Motion Carried.

It appears very little, if any clean-up progress has been made at 1440 Zeman Rd. The County's condemned sign is no longer visible. Joe Spitz will follow up with the County to see if the sign was removed by them for reasons unknown to us.

Scott Maciosek provided board members with a letter from Wisconsin DOT, advising the town that the state was unable to help fund the River Trail Bike Commission. The River Trail Commission is continuing their efforts on other grant opportunities and do have another zoom meeting set this month on the 14<sup>th</sup>.

Next board meeting is on November 4, 2020 at 11 AM.

There were no Public Comments.

Letters and Communication:

Millie Ritzer had attended the Eagle River Area Fire Department meeting and provided the town with the 2021 Proposed Budget. Town of Cloverland will see a .29% increase for 2021.
